

2011 Ute Cup 40th annual La Garita Colorado August 20th & 21st

This event is being held under a special use permit issued by the US Forest Service.

The RMTA works in cooperation with The US Forest Service to maintain trails in this area.

The Ute Cup is a trials/endurance event. It is a 2-day event and each day has a separate loop. Each loop is 15+ miles long with 20 sections. The loops will be ridden twice each day. The sections are set at the upper intermediate to lower advanced level. All competitors should be intermediate riders and up.

The Ute Cup is a 2-day event and the lowest score for both days will determine the Ute Cup winner.

Awards will be given to:

Ute Cup winner

Top rider each day

Top out of state rider (unless they are the Ute Cup Winner)

Top 40% of finishers for both days

Top RMTA class winners Intermediate - Pro

Top woman rider

Top senior riders age 35-39, 40-49 & 50+

Top 3 RMTA teams

Top 3 senior teams age 40+

Top 3 Visiting teams

Top 3 sponsored teams

All finishers will get a finishers pin.

The competition is limited to 100 competitors. Only the first 100 entries will be accepted.

All bikes must have USDA approved spark arrestors.

Colorado OHV permits are required. Go to the following site to get one.

All bikes must arrive clean. There will be an inspection to insure bikes are not carrying noxious weeds or mussels in dirt and mud on bikes.

Cost is \$50.00/rider. Entries must arrive before August 10th. A late fee of \$20.00 there after if we do not have 100 riders at that time.

There is a \$10.00 charge/team for riding on teams that will be collected at the event.

There is plenty of open camping at the trials site.

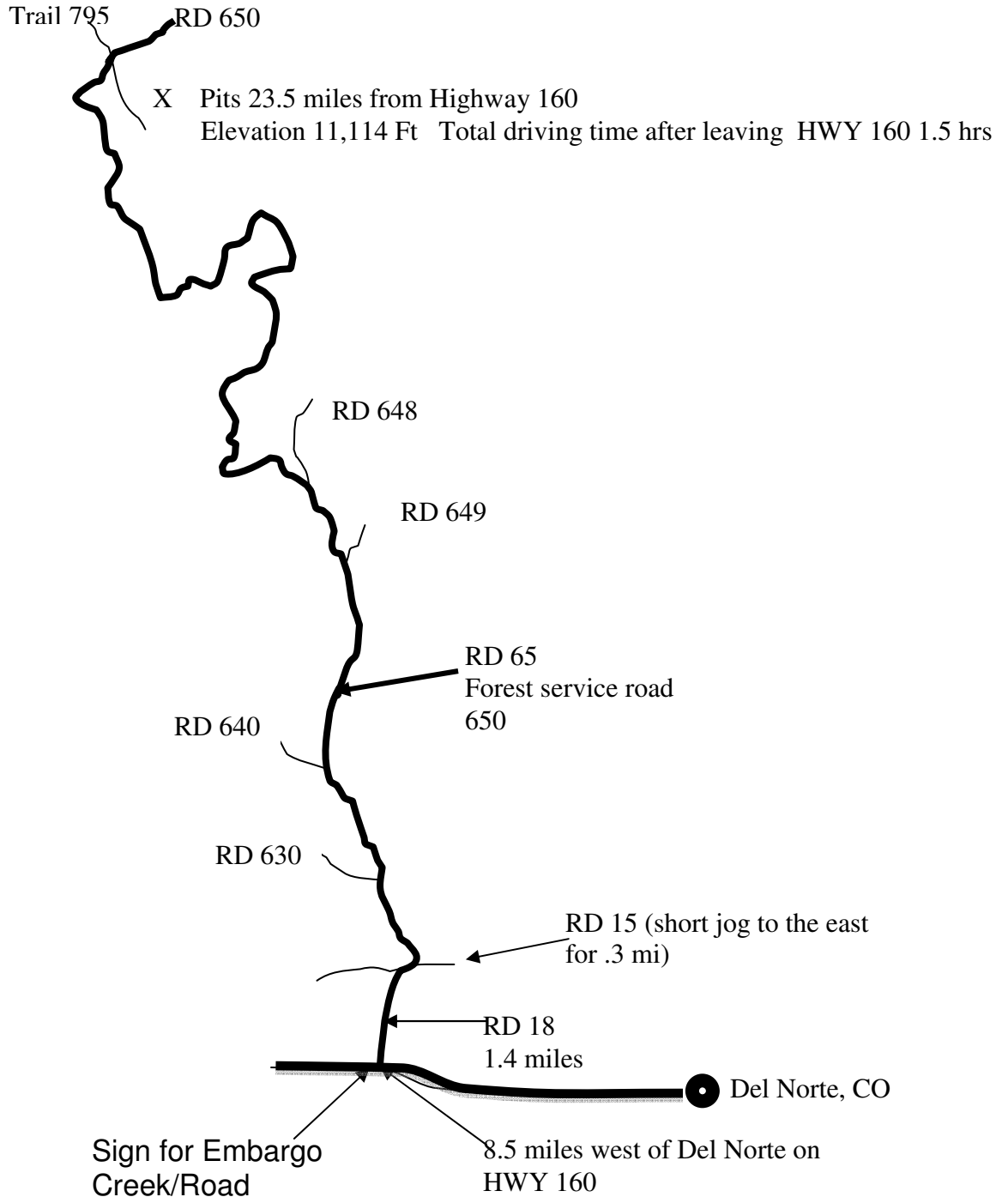

GPS 37 51.977N, 106 35.582W

Go west from Del Norte, CO on highway 160 for 8.5 miles. Turn right on road 18. Go north 1.4 miles. Turn right on road 15. Go east .3 miles. Turn left on road 65 (FS RD 650). Stay on 650 for 21.8 miles. The pits are in a meadow on the right (east) where trail 795 crosses the road 650. Road 650 is a dirt road with some narrow and rough spots. It takes approximately 1.5 hours to get to the pits after leaving HWY 160 driving a camper, a little less with a pickup.
